BRONZE STAR AWARD CRITERIA

- 1. Each year Floyd County will award two (2) Junior I (age 9 years or in the 3rd grade to ten years old as of September 1 of current year) with Bronze Star Awards.
- 2. All interested 4-H'ers must complete a District information sheet and return it to the Extension office by deadline
- 3. Record books will be required of all applicants and will represent 60% of the score. Books will be scored separately and by three judges different from the interview judges.
- 4. Interviews will represent 40% of the score. The interviews will include an opening threeminute presentation by the Bronze Star applicant followed by a six-minute question and answer time, which will be directed by the three judges.
- 5. No scholarships will be awarded to Bronze Star Award winners.
- 6. A 4-H'er may only receive the Bronze Star Award one time in his or her 4-H career.
